Information on the use of cookies

The website managed by the company ENERECO SPA (VAT code 01099200410), located in FANO (PS), Via Carpazi Division n. 14, as duly represented, uses cookies and similar technologies to ensure the correct functioning of the procedures, to improve the user experience of online applications and for its security.

This document provides detailed information on the use of cookies and similar technologies, how they are used by the company and how to manage them.

Definitions

Cookies are short text strings that the sites visited by the user send to their terminal (usually the browser), where they are stored before being re-transmitted to the same sites upon the next visit by the same user. During navigation on a site, the user can also receive cookies on their terminal that are sent from different websites or web servers (so-called "third parties"), where some of the elements of the visited site may be located (such as, for example, images, maps, sounds, specific links to pages of other domains).

Cookies, usually present in the users' browsers in very large numbers and sometimes persisting for a long time, are used for different purposes: authentication, session monitoring, storage of specific configuration information for the users that access the server, etc.

In this document we will refer to cookies and all similar technologies by simply using the term "cookies".

Types of cookies

Regarding the cookies used by the site managed by ENERECO SPA, based on the characteristics and their use, we can distinguish different categories:

a. Technical cookies.

Technical cookies are those used for the sole purpose of "transmitting a communication over an electronic communications network, or to the extent strictly necessary for an information society service provider that is explicitly requested by the subscriber or user to provide such service".

Such cookies are not used for further purposes and are installed directly by the website operator and used for system functions and for security reasons, or to monitor that the identity of the person performing the operation matches that of the person who is registered in the portal.

They can be divided into: navigation or session cookies, which ensure the normal navigation and use of the website (allowing, for example, to make a purchase or login to access restricted





areas); analytics cookies, similar to technical cookies when used directly by the site operator to collect information, in aggregate form, on the number of users and how they visit the site; functionality cookies, which allow the user to browse according to a series of selected criteria (for example, language, products selected for purchase) in order to improve the service to the user.

b. Profiling cookies.

Profiling cookies are designed to create profiles related to the user and are used in order to send advertising messages according to the preferences expressed by the user while navigating the net.

c. Third-party cookies Google Analitycs cookies

By visiting a website you may receive cookies both from the visited site ("owners") and from sites managed by other organizations ("third parties").

The presence of such plugins involves the transmission of cookies to and from all sites managed by third parties, and in particular components transmitted by Google Analytics, a web traffic analysis service provided by Google, Inc. ("Google").

These are also third-party cookies, collected and managed anonymously to monitor and improve the performance of the host site (performance cookies).

Google Analytics uses "cookies" to collect and analyze anonymous information on the behavior while using the website (including the user's IP address). This information is collected by Google Analytics, which processes it in order to draw up reports for the operators of ENERECO SPA regarding the activities on the websites. This site does not use (and does not allow third parties to use) the Google analysis tool to monitor or collect personal identification information. Google does not associate the IP address with any other data held by Google and does not attempt to link an IP address with the identity of a user. Google may also communicate this information to third parties where required by law or where such third parties process the information on Google's behalf.

Cookie management

The user can decide whether or not to accept cookies using the settings of their browser.

Attention: the total or partial disabling of technical cookies can compromise the use of site features reserved for registered users.

The disabling of "third-party" cookies does not affect navigation in any way.

The setting can be defined specifically for different websites and web applications. In addition, the best browsers allow you to define different settings for "proprietary" and "third-party" cookies.

As an example, in Firefox, through the menu Tools-> Options -> Privacy, you can access a control panel where you can define whether or not to accept the different types of cookies and remove them.
